Twenty-two persons, who were found to have developed I cancer Symptoms have been referred to the hospital for further treatment.



FARMING SYSTEM FOR NUTRITION CONFERENCE DATE : 06.08.2017

VENUE : MS SWAMY NATHAN FOUNDATION CHENNAI.

Voice Trust participated in the M.S. Swaminathan Research Foundation's (MSSRF) annual conference for 2017, based on the theme of 'Farming System for Nutrition held on 06/08/2017 at MSSRF in Chennai, India. The Regional Consultation aims to bring stakeholders from agriculture, nutrition, health and related domains to examine evidences on this theme from across the globe and within India. Agro-biodiversity, climate change, technology and the elements to bridge the gaps – gender, social inclusion and nutrition literacy will be explored.

Farm men and women shared experiences in bringing a nutrition focus to farming. FSN is an interventional approach that includes a combination of sustainable agricultural remedies involving advanced crop production practices, bio-fortification, promotion of backyard/community nutrition gardens of fruits and vegetables, livestock and poultry development, setting up of small-scale fisheries and regularising veterinary services as stimulant for rendering higher income and better nutrition output. Nutritional outcomes in a rural population improves through production and own consumption of nutrition-rich diverse diets or alternatively through higher incomes from sale of agricultural produce which is in turn used for addition or enrichment of diet with multi-nutrition-rich foods to often consumed staples.



NUTRITION EDUCATION PROGRAMME DATE : 12.08.2019

VENUE : THIYAGARAJAR ENGINEER COLLEGE, MADURAI



Awareness about nutrition can make a lot of difference in the health of the society and the country as a whole. Nutritional deficiencies can affect the entire population of a country reproduction, say experts through a little better off in terms of awareness; the urban population of the country seems to be no better than its rural counterparts in nutrition status.

Kids should get all the nutrition from whole some, balanced and natural diet available and acceptable locally instead of from nutrients embedded in chemically fortified food items. Critical cases need medical support and monitoring specially if there is a presence of infection like malaria, tuber culosis or HIV. To make it more cost effection for the poor.

We conducted health check-up by our experienced doctors of Velammal Hospital Madurai at school premises. We also provided the benefit of one-to-one consultation with the doctors and examination report of each and every child after the medical check-up to the school/parents. We provided detailed school health report after health check-up. This report explains the overall school health including list of students suffering different disease or deformity, it also provide list of students found under observations.

In recognition of our chairman T Murugesan's contribution in the field of Medical Awareness, Women's Development, Road Safety, Vocational Training, Health and Environmental factors for the past 22 years, On behalf of Ministry of Youth and Sports, Nehru Yuva Kendra, Govt of India awarded him with the "Life time Achievement Award".

This award was bestowed to him by the Nehru Yuva Kendra Deputy Director Tamilnadu and Pondichery Mr Sadaserval on 26/08/2017. The Scheme of Awards to Outstanding Youth Clubs was instituted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India and is being implemented by Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan. The Youth Clubs are basically an association of youth, working in the field voluntarily, in areas such as literacy, environment enrichment, women empowerment, vocational training, eradication of dowry, untouchability, forestation, health and family welfare etc.

The President of India launched a nationwide sanitation campaign "Swachhta Hi Seva" and administered the Swachhta Hi Seva Pledge whereby the Nation resolved to create a clean healthy and new India. India is fighting a decisive battle for cleanliness and hygiene.

According to UNICEF (United Nations Children's Fund) good sanitation can save Rs50,000 per year per family, The ministry has made elaborate plans along with the state governments to reach out to poor and marginalised and provide them with sustainable sanitation services. "Cleanliness is not the responsibility of only sanitation personnel and government departments; it is a multi-stakeholder national movement. We cleaned the entire Madurai Railway Station, Senior officials also participated in this programme.

The initiative, which is being coordinated by the ministry of drinking water and sanitation, will include 'sharamdaan' or voluntary work and will focus on mass mobilisation and reinforce 'jan andolan' for sanitation to contribute to Mahatma Gandhi's dream of a clean India." Sanitation is linked to various sectors. From health to giving security and dignity to women, sanitation also affects a country economically.

TRIBUTE TO PANDIT DEENDAYAL UPADHYAYA DATE : 25.09.2017

VENUE : VOICE TRUST OFFICE

Voice Trust in association with Nehru Yuva kendra paid tribute to Great soul Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya. His 110th Birthday was celebrated on 25/09/2017 at Madurai. Deendayal Upadhyaya (25 September 1916 – 11 February 1968) was an Indian politician and thinker of RSS ideology, and former leader of the political party Bharatiya Jana Sangh, the forerunner of Bharatiya Janata Party. He became president of the Jana Sangh in December 1967.

Upadhyaya borrowed the Gandhian principles such as sarvodaya (progress of all), swadeshi (Indianisation), and Gram Swaraj (village self-rule) and these principles were appropriated selectively to give more importance to cultural-national values. These values were based on an individual's undisputed subservience to the nation as a corporate entity. Upadhyaya considered that it was of utmost importance for India to develop an indigenous economic model with a human being at center stage. This approach made this concept different from Socialism and Capitalism.



On philosophical front, Deendayal Upadhyay is best remembered for his principle of "integral humanism", which has been defined as "a classless, casteless and conflict-free social order". It talks about the integration of indigenous "Indian culture" with the social, political and economic fabric of the nation.

We explained to the students about his life details. We conducted elocution, oratory competitions on this special day. Sweets were distributed to the local public by remembering the great Pandit Deendayal. Voice Trust Managing Trustee paid his respects and tributes to him.



GANDHI JEYANTHI CELEBRATION DATE : 02.10.2017

Our Trust organised and celebrated Gandhi Jeyanthi on 02/10/2017 at our office premises in remembrance of our great Leader. This Committee includes Hon'ble Vice-President, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Chief Ministers of all states of the country, representatives from across the political spectrum, Gandhians, thinkers, and eminent persons from all walks of life. Gandhi had a natural love for 'truth' and 'duty'. With his complete dedication and confidence, Gandhi freed India from the British Rule and proved the world that freedom can be achieved with non-violence. Even today his teachings are encouraged to stay away from violence and find peaceful solutions to conflicts. For Gandhi, Truth and Non-violence was his entire philosophy of life. Mahatma Gandhi was a man with simple tastes and values. With keeping that in mind and giving him full honour and respect the festivities on this day are very less. On 15 June 2007, The United Nations General Assembly announced that October 2nd will be celebrated as the International Day of Non-Violence. Sweets were distributed to the children and free food was provided to the people living in streets.

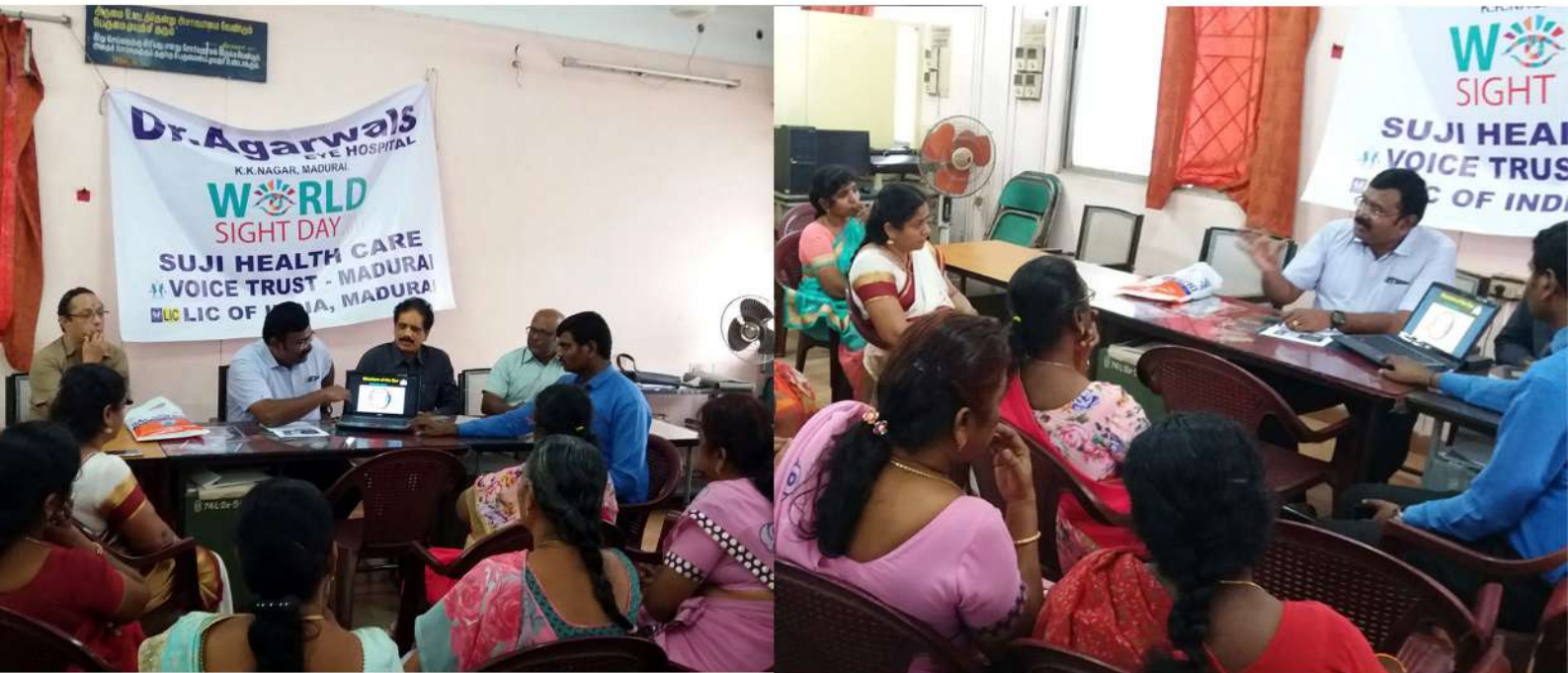

The Indian Constitution has certain core constitutional values that constitute its spirit and are expressed in various articles and provisions. In fact, in a layman's understanding, value is that which is very essential or 'worth having and observing' for the existence of human society as an entity. The Indian Constitution Contains all such values, the values that are the universal, human and democratic of the modern age.

The constitutional values are reflected in the entire Constitution of India, Its Preamble embodies 'the fundamental values and the philosophy on which the Constitution is based. These are: sovereignty, socialism, secularism, democracy, republican character, justice, liberty, equality, fraternity, human dignity and the unity and integrity of the Nation.

Moreover, teaching about constitution does not merely mean giving information and knowledge in the classroom, but it also covers all modalities which could sensitize a person, awaken his/her conscience and develop an attitude of behaving decently in a social set up. Voice Trust conducted Constitution Awareness Programme for Raja Engineering College students. 450 students participated & Benefited from this programme.

"The eye is the window to the world, at the same time, it is the window of the soul." - Shakespeare. Eyes play a vital role in our day to day lives and are perhaps the most precious gift we have. It can become embarrassing if we fail to recognize a person due to lack of good vision. However, health consequences of bad vision can be far worse.

A free Eye camp was organised by Voice Trust in association with Aravind eye Hospital, Madurai and Lions Club of Madurai Pandiyan at P.U.Union School, LKP Nagar, Sakkimangalam on 12/11/2017. Such initiatives are helpful for poor people who cannot afford expensive procedures and medicines.

The Impact of eye checkup camps are : Physical function, emotional wellbeing and overall quality of life can be enhanced, Enhanced and clearer visibility to read & write, Increased opportunity to continue or resume an occupation mainly for tailors, drivers etc., Increased mobility, Improvement in quality of life, Improved self-esteem and independence, Increased ability to avoid injury.

Awareness on various diseases of the Eye like Cataract, Glaucoma, Diabetic Retinopathy, Near Sightedness and Far Sightedness were given to the public.

People attending the free eye camp were evaluated for vision (refractive error), eye problems and those requiring surgery especially cataract were advised surgery. The cataract patients identified were referred to Aravind Eye Hospital, Madurai for free surgery. 150 people were screened and prescribed spectacles. Lions club Governors and members also participated actively in the programme.

The event took place in association with Mahatma Nursing School on 11/12/2017 at Maduari. Speech on Human Rights was delivered by our Chairman T Murugesan to the Para Medical Students. All religions are inspired in their own way by an innate concept of Human Rights. He emphasized that rights and duties are interlinked. While rights without duties lead to arrogance, duties without rights lead to slavery. Hence, there is a need to maintain balance between rights and duties. Human rights education is a lifelong process that builds knowledge and skills, as well as attitudes and behaviours, to promote and uphold human rights.

Spreading Human Rights awareness among the common people in their language is vital for creating a culture of human rights. Unless people are aware about their human rights they cannot protect their rights or seek redressal when it is violated. Human rights education is defined as the learning process that builds up the required knowledge, values, and proficiency of human rights of which the objective is to develop an acceptable human rights culture.

This type of learning teaches students to examine their experiences from the human rights point of view enabling them to integrate these concepts into their values and decision-making.

The emphasis on Human Rights Education began in 1995 with the beginning of the UN Decade for Human Rights Education, though previously addressed in 1953 with the UNESCO Associated Schools Program, which served as an "initial attempt to teach human rights in formal school settings". The first formal request for the need to educate students about human rights came about in UNESCO's 1974 article Recommendation concerning Education for International Understanding. Nehru Yuvakendra also participated in this programme. Appreciation gifts were given to the students to encourage them.

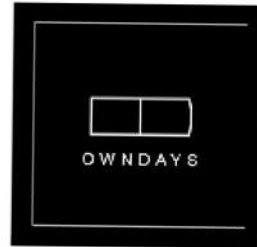
