

PROGRAMMES

HEALTH AND MEDICAL CAMPS

Voice Trust in association with Velammal Medical College Hospital & Research Institute, Madurai organized a Health Camp for the BAR ASSOCIATION LAWYERS, Madurai on 10.07.2019. Over 350 Advocates were screened and given medical advice at the special Medical Camp organised at the Court Premises. The main focus was on the changing lifestyle and food habits that people are adopting these days and the problems creeping up due to these sedentary habits. Various general preventions to cure these problems were also suggested by them.





A Free Blood Sugar and Free Bone Mass Index (BMI) check-up was also in place to check the density and mass of bones.

Voice Trust and Velammal Hospital acknowledged the support, transparency and patience exhibited by the team from the Madurai Bar Association towards the preparation of this successful camp. The President and Secretary of the Bar Association said that the main focus towards organizing such camps was allowing the participants to avail the benefits of such voluntary events.

Free Diabetic Camp

Madurai Voice Trust, Suji HealthCare Pvt Ltd and Apollo pharmacy jointly held a free Diabetes awareness camp on 24.08.2019 for the General Public near Meenakshi Amman Temple Madurai. During this camp height, weight, sugar and blood tests were done to rule out various diseases.



The camp was organized to make the people aware of the growing effects of diabetes keeping in view, the increase in the patients of diabetes during the last few years as the number of 32 millions in 2000 has increased the double at 63 millions in 2013.



The general public appreciated the efforts of Voice Trust, Madurai for creating awareness about the fast spreading disease because of change of the life style of the people at large. With increasing age, the best defence against disease is early detection possible only by regular screening. It is our endeavour to make quality healthcare and specialist doctors accessible to more number of people. As part of our social and outreach initiatives, we regularly conduct free health screening camps to create awareness about preventive health check and early detection of disease.

General Medical Health Camp

Voice Trust Madurai in association with Suji Health Care and Madurai Meenakshi Mission Hospital organized a free Medical camp for the employees of Arasan Ganesan Aluminum Industries on 16.10.2019



A thorough examination by the doctors were done and the prescribed medicines were provided free of charge.





Weight, Sugar test, ECG examination and Eye examinations were conducted by the medical team of Meenakshi Mission Hospital & Research Center. The event was finally graced by Mr. Ganesan Managing Director, Arasan Aluminum Industries. A total of 146 employees benefitted from this camp.

General Medical Health Camp

Free General Medical Camp was held on 18th Nov 2019 at Pandiyanadu Institute of Co-operative Management, Thirunagar, Madurai for the students of Diploma in Co-operative Management and Junior Inspectors of Co-operative Department. This programme was organised by Voice Trust, Suji Health Care Pvt Ltd and Apollo Speciality Hospitals Madurai.

The Programme was conducted in accordance with the celebration of the 66th year of Madurai District Co-operative Society.

Diabetes check-up, Height, weight, ECG and General Consultation were provided to 76 employees of Co-operative Department. A Blood Donation camp was also organized by GH to promote about Blood Donation. Dr Krithiga- General Physician of Apollo Speciality Hospitals gave a healthy feedback after examining the employees stating that most of them were hale and healthy.



Free General Medical Camp

Voice Trust, in association with Suji HealthCare, Lions Club of Sivakasi, and Madurai Meenakshi Mission Hospital organized a Free General Medical Camp at Arasan Ganesan Polytechnic, Sivakasi for the College students on 04.09.2019 Around 600 students attended and benefitted from the programme.

The medical camps also seek to provide both preventive and curative treatment for those who require special treatment from relevant hospitals. Conducting these camps for students also aims at providing free tests for diabetes, blood pressure, hemoglobin etc and also provides counseling for students by trained doctors and specialists.

Free General Medical Health Camp and Eye Screening Camp

HEALTH AND NUTRITION AWARENESS

Hepatitis-B Awareness

Hepatitis B is a viral infection that attacks the liver and can cause both acute and chronic disease. The virus is most commonly transmitted from mother to child during birth and delivery, as well as through contact with blood or other body fluids. It is a major global health problem. It can cause chronic infection and puts people at high risk of death from cirrhosis and liver cancer. A safe and effective vaccine that offers a 98-100% protection against hepatitis B is available. Preventing hepatitis B infection averts the development of complications including the development of chronic disease and liver cancer.



Hepatitis-B Awareness Seminar was conducted on 28.07.2019 at Madura Coats Private Limited by Voice Trust in association with Guru Hospital, for the employees. On this occasion Dr. Kalpana, Gynecologist and Dr. Vishnu Kumar, Pain Management Specialist, participated and explained in detail about the various liver diseases and how to prevent them. Around 70 people benefited from the programme.



"Hepatitis-B Awareness" was given to the North West Rotary Club executives and members at Hotel Star Residency on 28.07.2019. Dr A.C.Arun a leading Gastroenterologist, Hepatologist and Endoscopist in Madurai explained in detail about the liver disease and how to prevent them.

Health and Nutrition Awareness

Voice Trust and Apollo Hospital Madurai jointly organized a "Health and Nutrition Awareness" programme for Madurai Duraisamy Nagar Resident Association and their families on 09/06/2019.

World Breast Feeding Week Celebration

World Breastfeeding Week is celebrated every year from 1 to 7 August to encourage breastfeeding and improve the health of babies around the world.



. The World Breast Feeding Week was jointly organized by Voice Trust and Guru Hospital, Madurai for the Anganwadi Staff and pregnant women under the Integrated Rural Development Program on 07.08.2019 at the conference Hall, Guru Hospital. Dr. Kalpana, obstetrician specialist, clearly outlined the significance and usefulness of the "World Breast Feeding" week. Breastfeeding promotes better health for mothers and children alike. Increasing breastfeeding to near-universal levels could save more than 800 000 lives every year, the majority being children under 6 months





.WHO recommends exclusive breastfeeding starting within one hour after birth until a baby is 6 months old. Nutritious complementary foods should then be added while continuing to breastfeed for up to 2 years or beyond.

National Nutrition Week

Awareness seminar on National Nutrition Week Day was organized at Sri Meenakshi Govt.Arts College for Women(A), Madurai on 03-09.2019 which was organized by Voice Trust, Suji HealthCare, Lions Club of Pandian and Madurai Apollo Hospital. Breakfast is often avoided in today's environment. Eating more junk food and fast food has become a habit nowadays and loved by

everyone.



Our traditional food has been forgotten. The restaurants usually sell parotas made out of maida. This is loved and consumed by today's generation. The result is likely to be cardiovascular problems, High Blood pressure, Kidney failure and diabetes. If this continues we will lose a healthy India. The main emphasis was to switch to the

traditional foods and reduce the diseases. Around 500 students participated and benefitted from this programme.

This day also raised awareness for the prevention of child marriages because we can say that child marriage may be an indirect cause of maternal deaths. It is the right for every woman to take good quality nutrition proper healthcare services during

and after pregnancy and childbirth. In fact in India the government is also taking effort to reduce the maternal mortality rate but we can't ignore the fact that it is our duty also to take steps for women healthcare and if needed to educate them.



Awareness of eye diseases and their treatment can play an important role in seeking and accessing available services. Voice Trust in association with Agarwal Hospital provided awareness and screening of eye to the general public.



Eye-related symptoms are often ignored, leading to delayed presentation, which may culminate in ocular and visual disorders leading to temporary or permanent visual impairment and even blindness in some cases. Increased community awareness and knowledge of common eye diseases and their treatment options are important in promoting preventive ophthalmic care.

National Cancer Awaereness Day

National Cancer Awareness Day was observed on 7th November by Voice Trust in association with Meenakshi Mission Hospital and Suji Healthcare Pvt Ltd to generate early detection and creating awareness about cancer.



The day is marked to coincide with the birth anniversary of the eminent scientist Madame Curie. Marie Curie is remembered for her discovery of radium and polonium, and her huge involvement in the fight against cancer. Her work steered to the development of nuclear energy and radiotherapy for the treatment of cancer.

When one talks about Cancer, there is almost always an instant generation of fear in the heart. The reason behind this fear is usually the common belief that all types of cancer are fatally dangerous for people. However, the fact is that there is always a chance to cure cancer when it is caught at an early stage.



In India, the incidence of cancer is increasing rapidly; therefore it is important to step up cancer literacy and knowledge amongst the population.



It is true, that when detected at the last stage, there is a slim chance of cure, but this can be solved by raising awareness about the same so that it helps people detect the symptoms and be prepared in advance.

World Tuberculosis Day

Each year, we commemorate World Tuberculosis (TB) Day on March 24 to raise public awareness about the devastating health, social and economic consequences of TB, and to step up efforts to end the global TB epidemic. This year World Tuberculosis Day was celebrated by Voice Trust in association with self help groups. The date marks the day in 1882 when Dr Robert Koch announced that he had discovered the bacterium that causes TB, which opened the way towards diagnosing and curing this disease.



TB remains the world's deadliest infectious killer. Each day, nearly 4500 people lose their lives to TB and close to 30,000 people fall ill with this preventable and curable disease. Global efforts to combat TB have saved an estimated 54 million lives and reduced the TB mortality rate by 42%.



Stigma associated with TB disease may also place certain populations at higher risk. Stigma may keep people from seeking medical care or follow-up care for TB. But anyone can get TB. People with TB can be found in every state; where we work, where we live, where we learn, and where we spend time with family and friends.

TB infection is extremely common – about one-quarter of the world's population is estimated to be infected. Preventive treatment for tuberculosis can stop TB infection from turning into disease.

EYE DONATION AWARENESS

Blindness is one of the major public health problems in the developing countries. According to World Health Organization, corneal diseases (Damage to the tissue covering the front of eye called cornea) are among the major causes of vision loss and blindness, after cataract and glaucoma.

In most cases, loss of sight can be corrected through 'Eye Donation" After the death of a person, various organs can be donated and can be surgically transplanted to the patients who need them. One such organ is the eye .By donating eyes after death, a corneal blind person can see again through a surgical procedure known as corneal transplantation, where by the damaged cornea is replaced by a healthy cornea from the eye donor.



Voice Trust in association with Suji HealthCare conducted an "Eye Donation Awareness camp" on 23.09.2019 at Vellaichamy Nadar College, Madurai as part of the National Welfare Program. The programme was presided by Mr. Jawahar, Principal of the college. The special invitee for the ceremony was Mr. Veerasamy, a Senior ophthalmologist, said that if one donates one eye, it can be used for up to four people. He said that students should be aware of the donation and make it known to others. Director of Voice Trust said that the students should be restrained from using their cell phone for long period of time. The event was attended by Lions Club Mr. Natarajan. Dr. Senthil Pandiyan, Welfare Program Officer ended the programme with vote of thanks.



YOGA DAY CELEBRATION

The International Day of Yoga has been celebrated annually on 21 June since 2015, following its inception in the United Nations General Assembly in 2014. EYE SCREENING

Vision and learning are closely related to each other and school is the first formal space for learning. Since 80% of what a child learns is visual, in case, they have a problem she/he suffers not only from poor vision but also faces critical setbacks in development. When children have difficulty in seeing clearly, be it the blackboard or their books, it hampers their ability to learn in the classroom with their peers.



School-age children constitute a particularly vulnerable group because of the high prevalence of refractive error — myopia, hypermetropia, and astigmatism. Refractive errors may not be addressed for a variety of reasons, including lack of awareness by the individual or their family, children not realizing that they are not seeing clearly, limited availability, or affordability of refractive services including glasses and cultural stigma that discourage the use of glasses.



Therefore, the key role of school eye health programs is to identify children with eye problems as early as possible and provide quality treatment on time. School eye health programs also help increase awareness among children, teachers, and school staff as well as parents about the importance of eye health and need for preventive or regular eye examinations. Timely intervention contributes to the improved participation of children within the school system— both academics as well as cocurricular activities helping them realize their full potential.

which will give raise to a healthier generation. Dengue is transmitted by bite of Aedes aegypti mosquito infected with any one of the four dengue viruses. This mosquito bites only during daylight hours. Dr Mariappan highlighted on the breeding sites and prevention methods. Specimens of the Dengue mosquito were shown to the students.

During transmission season(rainy season) all persons can wear clothes that cover arms and legs. Dengue patient should be prevented from mosquito bites. This will prevent further spread of dengue to other persons.



The programme was concluded with an Oath to eradicate Dengue. A total of 750 students benefitted from this programme.

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATION

A platform for action World Environment Day is the United Nations day for encouraging worldwide awareness and action to protect our environment. Since it began in 1974, the event has grown to become a global platform for public outreach that is widely celebrated in over 100 countries.



The people's day Above all, World Environment Day is the "people's day" for doing something to take care of the Earth. Each World Environment Day is organized around a theme that draws attention to a particularly pressing environmental concern. The theme for 2019 is "Air pollution".



On this occasion Dr. Mariappan, Ex Scientist at Indian Institute of Science-(ICMR) explained about the environmental awareness and the dangers of dengue and how we can protect ourselves. The event was attended and benefited by approximately 450 school students.

DENGUE AWARENESS

"Good health and good sense are two of life's greatest blessings" but now a day some dangerous diseases effects on health very much like one of its example is Dengue Fever.



Dengue fever, also known as break bone fever, is a mosquito-borne infection that can lead to a severe flu-like illness. It is caused by four different viruses and spread by *Aedes* mosquitoes. There are currently no vaccines. The Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimate that 400 million people are infected each year.



Voice Trust in association with Anandam Lions Club and Suji HealthCare organization held an "Environment and Dengue Awareness Programe" at Arulmigu Lord Subramania Swamy Girls' Higher Secondary School, Tiruparankundaram on 19.07.2019.



About 600 people benefited from the event. The students were involved in an interactive session on Dengue Awareness.

DENGUE PREVENTION

Voice Trust Madurai, Suji Health Care and Madurai Apollo Hospital conducted a Dengue Prevention & Awareness programme for the Theni District Police Family in Coordination with Police Department of Theni District on 18.10.2019. The event was inaugurated by Sri.V.Baskaran, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Theni District.



Dr. Mariappan, Ex.Scientist., - ICMR, in his speech said that dengue is a widespread disease in the rainy season. The disease is spread by stangnant water in plastics, tires and aquatic waste in our surroundings. So we need to keep our surroundings clean. He said the disease could be avoided by preventing mosquito bites in areas with clean air.



Dr.G.Venugopalan, MD., (Geriatric Medicine)., Apollo Specialty Hospitals, Madurai said, Dengue fever is a curable disease. A person suffering from dengue fever may be deficient in water. To control this we have to drink a solution made up of salt and sugar in drinking water. People suffering from the disease should consult the doctor and take medication.



SRI.ELAMARAN, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Armed Reserve, Theni District finally ended the programme with vote of thanks. About 200 people benefited from the programme.

Dengue Awareness Programme

AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON CLEANLINESS

This Awareness Programme was conducted at Agricultural College and Research Institute, Madurai under ICAR Development Grant SC Plan- 2019-2020 in association with Agricultural College and Research Institute, Madurai and Apollo Speciality Hospitals, Madurai on 07.03.2020.



Special lecture on Health and Cleanliness was delivered on Preventive Health from Apollo Speacility Hospital.



A total of 300 students were benefitted by this programme.



The awareness programme on Cleanliness, Health, and Nutrition is conducted with a view to equip the students about health and hygiene, about various nutritious food that they should take while they are still growing physically and also how to overcome stress and tensions in their early age. Through collaborated efforts like these, the need to spread awareness programme to adolescent girls & boys of the state and also rural areas is very important.

CORONA VIRUS AWARENESS

The corona virus death toll has risen past 2000 in mainland China as per National Health Commission's report and more than 75,000 people have been affected worldwide. In India, Kerala initially reported three cases of infection, and two had tested negative.

In view of this, a special session was conducted at M.E.P.U.P. School in Andarkttaram on 13.03.2020 in association with Voice Trust and Suji Healthcare for making students aware of this virus.



The safety, health and well-being of our students and staff is our top priority. Voice Trust is raising awareness against the corona virus as a precaution, though are stressing that parents should not panic as schools are "completely safe". A detailed session was conducted in which students were told them that school is taking the necessary steps and they are completely safe.



During the session we have been discussing washing hands regularly, keeping mouth covered when coughing or sneezing and hands covered when you are dealing with edible items.

Thereafter Symptoms of the virus were discussed:

As this is also flu season, we continue to remind students to follow proper hand washing techniques. Signs are also around schools as reminders for students, staff and visitors as well. They were informed that every student can protect against infections by practising good hand hygiene and respiratory hygiene. Students showed a great interest in attending this session as they found it very useful, they got to know how to take care of themselves and their family from this dangerous virus. A total of 159 students and 100 women benefitted from this programme.

Under this program, to address the soaring demand of quality sanitizers, especially across hospitals and frontline workers who are relentlessly serving COVID-19 patients, Voice Trust donated Masks and Hand Sanitizer Gel for to frontline workers in COVID designated hospitals across the city.

Under the Government of India's Remote Medical Services Program, Voice Trust has been the partner of Tata Tele medicine. The biggest advantage for patients is that they can now consult the best doctors in the county remotely and get treated for their illness.



We have initiated a telemedicine project to serve the needs of communities in the remotest parts Madurai, Theni, Bodi and Kadamalaikundu



Based on the 'hub-andspoke 'model, the project will provide diagnostics and medical consultation services through video conferencing with specialized doctors and equipment available at the telemedicine clinics.








