

The free Health and Medical camps organized by Voice Trust play a crucial role in providing much-needed healthcare services to underserved communities. By focusing on preventive care, health education, and early detection of health issues, these camps contribute to the overall well-being and improved healthcare outcomes for individuals in need.





#### Free Health Check up for the Elderly

The camp was held in Madurai for senior citizens on 10th April 2022. All the participants were given instructions to be more cautious about their health and get their medical check up done from time to time. The camp was a big draw with a stream of senior citizens trooping in and out of the venue all day long to avail the services on offer. At the camp, tests for blood pressure, Sugar, hypothyroid was carried along with general check up. A free medical consultation was also provided during the camp. More than 85 people were benefited from the camp.



#### Free Cardiac Screening Camp

To improve the availability and access to quality health care by people, especially for those residing in rural areas, under the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme, Voice Trust in association with Hannah Joseph Hospital Madurai and Primary Health Centre Checkanurani conducted Free Cardiac Screening Camp at PHC Checkanurani on the 21st Dec 2022. Dr Gilbert Joseph MS., M.Ch (CTVS) Chief Cardiac Surgeon and Dr S.Jegan MD., DM Interventional Cardiologist of Hannah Joseph Hospital examined around 60 persons who attended the camp. In the camp, ECG, ECHO, blood sugar, blood pressure, were performed by specialized paramedical staff and proper medical consultation from experienced cardiologist doctors were provided free of cost and many important medicines were also provided free of cost. This day is to remind every individual on the importance to maintain a healthy heart by following the right lifestyle pattern and accessing timely healthcare. Timely diagnosis and intervention plays a key role in saving lives, but all this can be achieved through constant awareness. Health camps such as ours will educate communities, and ultimately save lives.

#### **Free Multispecialty Medical Camp at Sivakasi**

On 24<sup>th</sup> Jan 2023, Voice Trust in association with Lions Club Sivakasi and Suji Healthcare Pvt Ltd, Madurai conducted a free Multispecialty Medical Camp at The Arasan Aluminium Industries (P) Ltd Sivakasi for the welfare of the employees of The Arasan Group of Industries. The camp was carried out based on the theme of "Health is more important than Wealth". Hannah Joseph Hospital, The Eye Foundation and Nala Dental Hospital rendered the Medical services to 415 employees. Eye check up, Dental check-up, Echo, ECG and general health parameter tests were conducted.









#### Free Eye Health Camp in Tirunelveli District

Eye camp is the most effective way of providing eye care service to a large number of people in a short time. We identify a large number of cataract patients through these eye camps. It is completely free for patients. On the 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022, Voice Trust in association with The Eye Foundation, Eye Hospital organized a Mega free Eye Health Camp at Kayathar Tollgate in Tirunelveli District. The objective of this initiative is to ensure clearer vision and safe travel for truck and bus drivers who are the most frequent users of national highways. In these eye camps basic services were provided such as screening and correcting refractive errors by providing eye glasses, providing medicines to address allergy and other eye conditions, identification of cataract and other surgical cases.









#### Free Medical Camp and Beneficiary welfare Scheme

On the 12<sup>th</sup> of Oct 2022, Free Medical Camp and a Beneficiary welfare Scheme was organized at Poonjuthi Village in Madurai District. This program was organized by Mr Ramanathan, Panchayat President Poonjuthi Village in association with Voice Trust, BenchMark Medical Trust, Harsitha Hospital, Vasan Eye Care Hospital, CSI Dental College, Lady Doak College and Suji Healthcare System Madurai. Free General, Eye, Dental, ENT and Ortho Checkups were conducted to around 350 people. Free medicines were also provided. 200 shirts, sponsored by Ramraj Cotton were given to daily wage labourers. Sewing machines were provided to the needy. Around 10000 tree saplings were planted. Appreciation prizes were given to the best MGNRES workers.

#### Postpartum Mental Health For New Moms

While pregnancy and the birth of a child are momentous experiences in a person's life, the transition also brings a host of challenges for the new mother, with mainly having to adjust to this new life — taking care of the baby and also making sure her own physical and emotional healing is taking place simultaneously. It can also result in something you might not expect — depression. Most new moms experience postpartum "baby blues" after childbirth, which commonly include mood swings, crying spells, anxiety and difficulty sleeping. Baby blues typically begin within the first two to three days after delivery, and may last for up to two weeks. But some new moms experience a more severe, long-lasting form of depression known as postpartum depression. Rarely, an extreme mood disorder called postpartum psychosis also may develop after childbirth.

On 25<sup>th</sup> April, the awareness of postpartum depression awareness was imparted in Lady Doak College. Sometimes it's simply a complication of giving birth. If you have postpartum depression, prompt treatment can help you manage your symptoms and help you bond with your baby.



#### <u>"Happy Schooling" Program in Theni District</u> Mental Health and Rehabilitation Awareness

Voice Trust in association with M.S. Chellamuthu Trust and Research Foundation and SCISM Matric Higher Secondary School, Bodinayakanoor Theni Distirct conducted Mental Health and Rehabilitation Awareness Program on the 25<sup>th</sup> Nov 2022. The session was organized at SCISM School for the benefit of Students, Teachers and Parents. Teachers played a major role in identifying and preventing children from getting affected by psychological problems; psychological problems are preventable, treatable and curable provided prompt action was taken, said Dr C. Ramasubramanian, founder and senior consultant psychiatrist, M.S. Chellamuthu Trust and Research Foundation. The event was held as part of the World Mental Health Day celebration. A series of programmes were held as part of the event. 'Happy Schooling' project is aimed at building mental strength of children. Director T Murugesan, Voice Trust and a team of Psychologists were present at the event.













#### **Managing Stress and Improving Mental Health**

Voice Trust in collaboration with Madurai Kamaraj University Women's study centre organized a special lecture program on "Managing stress and improving Mental Health". This event was mainly for the students of School of Tamil Studies, MKU and was conducted at Sethupathi Arangu on the 14<sup>th</sup> Oct 2022. The welcome address was delivered by Dr R.Radhika Devi, Director I/C, Womens Study Centre Madurai Kamaraj University. The inaugural address was delivered by Prof.V.Ramarajapandian, Chairperson School of Tamil Studies, MKU. Dr B.Ravichandran, Senior Counsellor, Dept of Psychiatry, Velammal Medical College & Hospital, Madurai, addressed the audience with a special speech on how the students could cope with mental stress. Mr T.Murugesan, Managing Trustee, Voice Trust gave the students with some life time examples on the importance of college life. The vote of thanks was delivered by Dr B.Sankareswari, Asst Professor School of Tamil Studies, MKU.











**Internship Training Programs** 

#### Disaster Management, Health and Hygiene Internship Training <u>Program</u>

Training on disaster Management was provided to Post Graduate students persuing Social Work from Alagappa University and Bharathiar University for a period of one month starting from 9<sup>th</sup> June 2022. Online and offline Disaster Management classes were conducted by Eminent personnels. They were also provided with hands on training of practical classes. The trainees attended zoom meeting for orientation about disaster management, health and hygiene.

Awareness program on "disaster management, health & hygiene, post and pre Covid 19" was conducted to the children of Govt Higher Secondary School Andarkottaram in the presence of Mr. Thennavan, the Head Master of SJGHSS and Dr. T.Mariyappan (Ex. Scientist ICMR). Health & Hygiene awareness were given to the school children of the Govt elementary school in Aandar Kottaram. This awareness program is a method of Social Work, which develops the ability of establishing constructive relationship in the individuals through group activities and to prepare people for social change. Thus the trainees formed group of children with same problem to bring back to the normal state. Around 200 children benefitted through this program.

Practical training were given to the trainees through visit to Mannar Thirumalai Naickar College in Pasumalai, Madurai, where they were exposed to various stalls in the exhibition like, Madhavan Heart care, Life care diagnosis and Surya surgical solutions. The trainees learned about how to do provide treatment for heart patients during First aid and also they learned about the benefits of some equipments used in the hospital sector. Field visit to Gandhigram Rural Institute was conducted, professor of Cooperation, Mr. Manivel explained about aspects of disaster management and also explained phases of disaster and how to be handled and how do we overcome that. Mr. Manzoor, research scholar for Gioinformatics shared relevant information about the various types of landslides, calculations and explained in overall information about landslides.

Trainees utilized this opportunity in purposeful manner and learned many activities through field visits and Training in VOICE TRUST in Madurai. In this Concurrent field work, Social work trainees practiced the direct methods of social work that is case work, group work, community organization program and got some improvement in professional attitudes.










CANCER SCREENING CAN Jave YOUR LIFE



#### **Mobile Cancer Screening**

"The launch 'Mammobus,' a mobile cancer screening unit, is a pioneering effort ensuring equality of access, much similar to the State government's efforts to reach the lowest strata of the society through 'Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam' initiative'. The first Mammobus in Madurai, was donated by Rotary International District 3,000 through Madurai Rotary Ladies Forum to S.G. Balamurugan, chairman of Guru Hospital. Voice Trust joined hands with Guru Hospital to create awareness of cancer among the public, especially among the rural folk. Dr. Balamurugan said that early diagnosis is very crucial to treat any type of cancer. "People from the rural areas will have easy and free of cost access to screen for many types of cancer". The unit comprises high-end equipment, including mammogram, pap smear to diagnose breast cancer and cervical cancer respectively, ultrasound scan to detect other cancers. The unit is also equipped with a large LED display which would be used to create on-the-go awareness.



#### **Pink October - Cancer Awareness Celebration**

Breast Cancer Awareness Month, is a global healthcare event for the awareness of breast cancer, which is reminisced for the entire month of October every year for the past 37 years since 1985. This year (2022), on the 16<sup>th</sup> of Oct, Voice Trust in association with Guru multispeciality hospital Situated at Madurai which is a world class medical centre in India pioneering in the field of cancer care and the Association of Surgeons of India conducted the awareness on Caner in Madurai through a Mini marathon in which ladies, men and children of various age group participated. # Project On Health - Hygiene & Nutrition program in schools

Incidence of disease is significantly reduced by Health Awareness. Voice Trust implemented the CSR Project on "Health-Hygiene & Nutrition in Schools" in association with Rajmahal Silks, Madurai in the month of August 2022. The program aim was to provide timely support and preventive measures to improve the health of school children, which can be associated with their cognitive development, learning, and academic performance. We at Voice Trust provided health education to school children who have limited information. We empowered them with knowledge to choose healthy habits and make modifications in lifestyle which reduce morbidity.

We focused on diverse health topics to provide awareness to the children and increase their levels of Health Literacy. Our focus areas were Health & Hygiene, Hand Washing, Menstrual Hygiene, Oral Hygiene, Nutrition & Balanced Food, Dengue, Anaemia, Eye Care and Environment Sanitation.

The programs were organised at various schools in Madurai East block emphasising on the immense significance of hygiene during the pandemic. We understand the significance of personal hygiene for girls, especially those from the low income background, explained the adolescent girls about the significance of maintaining personal hygiene, including basic practices such as brushing teeth and washing hands along with good menstrual hygiene practices, having nutritious food and personal safety. We spoke of how good hygiene reduces the possibility of infections and ensures a healthier and happier life. Dr. Mariappan, Ex Scientist of Indian Institute of Science-(ICMR) elaborated the children about various diseases and explained about the environmental awareness and the dangers of dengue and how we can protect ourselves. The students & Professors of Meenakshi College joined hands with us in the execution of the program. The importance of Health-Hygiene & Nutrition were imparted to the school children through various means :

- Skits
- Quiz program with prizes
- Display of Nutritious & Well Balanced Foods
- Exhibits of Colourful Visual Aids like Posters, Charts & Models

The program improved students' health status. All the key informants in these programs were successful in improving students' general knowledge of health and nutrition. Furthermore, the program also brought positive changes in students' nutritional behaviours, hygiene practices, and life skills. Students' awareness on hygiene and sanitary practices has improved. Altogether more than 800 students have benefitted through the programs.












## **Alcohol Awareness Activities**

















#### **Digital Classroom Inauguration**


