Mega General Medical Camps: Organized large-scale medical camps, providing free healthcare services and consultations to thousands of individuals.

Cardiology Medical Camps: Conducted detection of potential cardiac issues and also raised awareness about cardiovascular health and encouraged the adoption of healthy lifestyles.

Free Eye Camps: Held multiple eye camps, offering vision screenings, prescription glasses, and treatment for eye ailments, addressing the critical need for eye care in the region.

Cancer Screening Program: Conducted comprehensive screening programs for cancer and eye diseases, reaching out to underserved communities and providing early detection and treatment.

Health Awareness Campaigns: Conducted awareness campaigns and education programs on dengue prevention and management, Healthy Lifestyle and No tobacco emphasizing the importance of community involvement



Free Mega Medical Camp at Tamil Nadu Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Madurai

Voice Trust, in collaboration with the Tamil Nadu Chamber of Commerce and Industry and Velammal Hospital Madurai, orchestrated a highly successful free medical checkup camp on February 24th 2024. This initiative aimed to provide essential healthcare services to the community, with specialist doctors from Velammal Hospital offering tests and consultations.



During the inauguration, Mr. Muthuramalingam underscored the critical importance of health camps for individuals in need of medical care. He emphasized the necessity for more health screening camps, particularly in densely populated areas, to cater to diverse medical cases effectively.

The health camp, held at the chamber premises on Kamarajar Salai in Madurai, was inaugurated by Mr. M.V. Muthuramalingam, Chairman of Velammal Educational Trust, in the esteemed presence of Dr. N. Jegatheesan, President of the Tamil Nadu Chamber of Commerce and Industry, and other distinguished guests.



Dr. N. Jegatheesan highlighted the chamber's centennial milestone and praised hospitals like Velammal Hospital for their contribution in positioning Madurai as a burgeoning medical hub. Such institutions play a pivotal role in promoting medical tourism by providing top-notch healthcare services.



The free medical camp offered a comprehensive range of services including consultation, ECG, Ultrasound scan, Eye checkup, Heart checkup, BP monitoring, Women's health checkup, Children's checkup, and complimentary medicines. Notably, around 311 individuals benefitted from this camp, receiving essential healthcare services and consultations from expert medical professionals.



Among the notable attendees at the inaugural function were Mr. S. Sridhar, Secretary of the Tamil Nadu Chamber of Commerce, Mr. J. Selvam, Vice-President, and Mr. T. Murugesan, Founder of Voice Trust.



Health check-up, Blood Camp at TNSTC (Madurai)

A camp for blood donation and general health check-up was organized at Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (TNSTC) headquarters main office premises situated on Bypass Road in Madurai on July 28th 2023.

General Medical Camp at Madurai Kamaraj University

A health screening camp was organized at Madurai Kamaraj University (MKU) Women's Studies Centre in Madurai on July 14th 2023 with a special focus heart-cardiac where the doctors' team had focused on height, weight, blood pressure, blood sugar, ECG, ECHO and eye checkup. This health screening camp took place in MKU Multi Speciality Health Centre of the university near varsity campus here in which 162 persons had undergone important medical tests today benefiting the MKU employees, their families and local people near university campus in Madurai.



The health screening camp by MKU Women's Studies Centre was organized in collaboration with Voice Trust & Suji Health Centre in Madurai, Hannah Joseph Hospital-Madurai and The Eye Foundation Eye Hospital in the MKU health centre very near to the university campus, from 10 am to 2 pm on July 14th 2023.



Dr.R.Radhika Devi, Director in-charge of MKU Women's Studies Centre, Mr.T.Murugesan, director, Voice Trust-Madurai and Dr.J.Klaassen Solomon, medical officer of MKU Multispeciality Health Centre, were among those who were present at the inauguration of health screening camp in which more than 150 men and women had undergone medical tests and health screening by doctors.

TB Awareness and Prevention Camp

Under the aegis of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav', Voice Trust in association with Madurai-Kanyakumari Tollway Ltd, CUBE Highways organized a TB Awareness and Prevention Camp on 28th July 2023 for the benefit of Kappalur Toll plaza Employees.



To raise awareness about TB among the employees, Voice trust collaborated with the District TB centre Elimination Programme. The District Tuberculosis Centre (DTC) is the nodal point for tuberculosis (TB) prevention and care activities in the district. An oath was taken by everyone present in the camp to eradicate TB headed by the Medical Officer, District Tuberculosis centre.

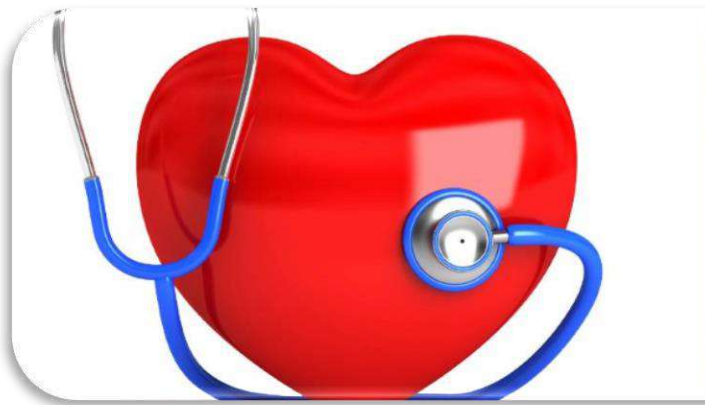


Medical camp at Kappalur Toll Plaza

Cardiac Consultation and Screening Camp

Voice Trust in collaboration with Hannah Joseph Hospital, Madurai organized a Cardiology Medical Camp on 11th April 2023. The camp aimed to provide specialized cardiac care and diagnostic services to the employees of EB Office in K Pudur, Madurai. The medical camp witnessed the participation of 70 individuals from the office.





The diverse group included people of different ages and backgrounds. A total of 16 ECG tests were conducted during the camp. ECGs are essential diagnostic tests that provide valuable information about the electrical activity of the heart. Six echocardiograms were performed. Echocardiography uses ultrasound to visualize the structure and function of the heart, enabling the identification of various cardiac conditions





One participant required further evaluation and was referred to another hospital for an angiography procedure. Angiography is a specialized test that helps assess the blood flow in the coronary.





Health and Eye Camp at Lady Doak College

Voice Trust organized a Women's Health Camp and Eye Camp at Lady Doak College in Madurai on March 5th, 2024, catering to the students and staff of LDC.

The Women's Health Camp provided essential medical services tailored to the needs of the attendees. This included general medical tests such as blood sugar monitoring, height and weight measurements, and specialist consultations. Led by Dr. Hemalatha, an esteemed professional with qualifications in M.D, D.G.O, and D.N.B from Hema Medical Centre, the camp aimed to address the healthcare requirements of both students and staff.



Simultaneously, MaxiVision Superspeciality Eye Hospital conducted an Eye Camp, offering specialized eye care services to the LDC community. This included screenings, consultations, and treatments for various eye-related concerns. The success of the medical camp underscored the value of community-based healthcare interventions in promoting a healthier society.







Dengue Awareness in Schools

Voice Trust conducted a series of successful Dengue Awareness Programs at 24 Government Schools of Madurai in the month of July and Aug 2023.

The aim of the program was to educate and raise awareness among the students about Dengue fever, its prevention, and the importance of early detection. The Highlights of the program included Interactive Sessions, and education on Prevention Measures, Identifying Breeding Sites and Early Detection. The students were educated about various preventive measures, including maintaining a clean and mosquito-free environment, using mosquito nets, and wearing protective clothing. The education also imparted about the Identification of Breeding Sites and early detection. The students actively participated in a Q&A session, clarifying their doubts and misconceptions related to Dengue fever.







Dengue Awareness for the General Public

On the 22nd Oct 2023 Voice Trust in association with NSS unit of M.A.V.M.M Hr Sec School and Suji Healthcare Madurai organized Dengue Awareness session for the welfare of the general public at URANGANPATTI near Karupayurrani, Madurai. The awareness programme educated the general public about dengue-causing mosquitoes, fever prevention etc through interactive sessions.

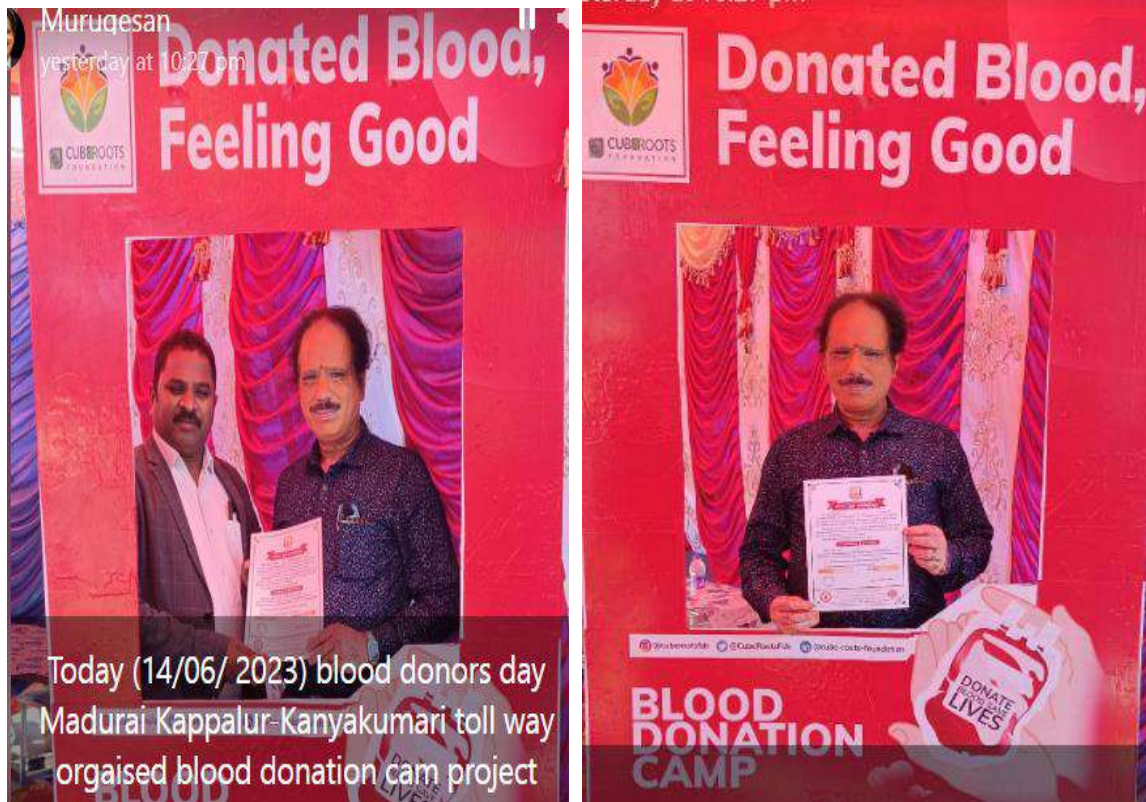
Eye awareness to Retired Pensioners on World Sight Day

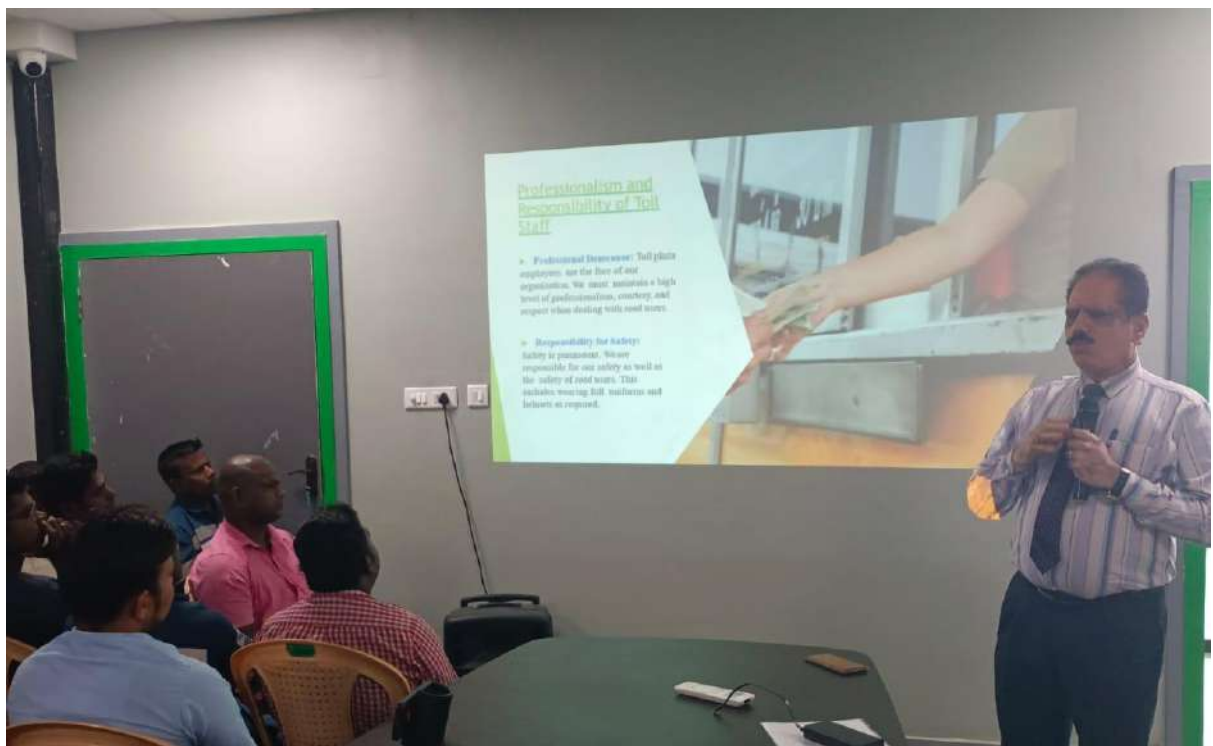




Customer Relationship Training program
